

School Readiness & Our Philosophy

Our programme uses a holistic approach supporting all children in the development of foundation learning skills.

We provide them with educational, cultural and social experiences that will enable them to enter the school setting as confident, capable and motivated learners.

What does a general day at Treetops look like?

- Most of our tamariki arrive by 9:00.
- Between 9:00-9:30, morning tea is provided by our own personally trained cook.
- 09:30-11:00, each room/age group will engage in their own planned activities for the day.
- 11:00-11:30, what time is it? It's time for lunch!
- 11:30-14:00, for our younger Tamariki that still require a nap, this is when they will have a rest. For our older Tamariki, they will carry on with their planned activities for the day.
- 14:00-14:30, afternoon tea time!
- 14:30-18:00, Tamariki will play and enjoy the afternoon while they wait for mum, dad or their caregiver to come pick them up.

Holiday Discount

After attending the centre for 3 months, your tamariki will be entitled to 3 weeks holiday discount per year (50% off normal fees).

The holiday discount runs from 1 January to 31 December of the same year and unused days are not able to be carried over to the following year.



Sleeping @ Treetops

Each child that requires a nap, has his/her own stretcher and sleeping bag that gets washed regularly.

For our little tamariki, we provide designated sleeping cots that are only for their private use.

Sleeping times are recorded and tamariki are monitored by the kaiako durng their naps.

Morning Tea Examples

Wholemeal crackers with cheese slices, banana & stewed apples.

Crumpets with jam, banana and strawberries.

Weetbix with milk, banana and stewed apple.

Yoghurt or soy yoghurt with banana and stewed apple.

Lunch Examples

Beef Lasagne with cheese, spinach, courgette, capsicum and homemade garlic bread.

Beef and lentil burgers with cheese, lettuce and cherry tomatoes.

Macaroni cheese with kidney beans, steamed carrots, broccoli and peas.

Teriyaki beef stir fry noodles with peas and carrots.

Chicken pasta bake with white sauce, peas, carrots & corn.

Pumpkin soup with split peas, kumara, carrots and cheesy garlic bread.

Rice cakes with cheese slices, cucumber, stewed apple and oranges.

Cheese scroll with apple and kiwifruit.

Blueberry muffins with oranges and bananas.

Oat slice with bananas.

Sandwiches with cheese and marmite with kiwifruit and pineapple.

Banana bread with milk mandarins and pears.

Homemade savoury cheese scrolls with pineapple and mango.

Toasted fruit bread, oranges, kiwifruit, milk.
